Contract Award

100,000 gal/day Groundwater Treatment System to Remove 1,4-Dioxane

London, Ontario, Canada - Purifics has been awarded a contract to supply a Photo-Cat water purification system for the treatment of groundwater contaminated with 1,4-dioxane, TCE and other contaminants. Approval of the groundwater interim remedial action plan (IRAP) was granted by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection in April 2006. The site is located on the west coast of Florida. The groundwater treatment plant will be operational in August of 2006.

The award also includes the fully automated control system for the 10 collection wells, remote monitoring, data logging, and system diagnostics.

The Photo-Cat process is a Photocatalytic technology and will treat to purity better than 3 ppb. In layman's terms, 3 ppb is like 3 seconds in 31.7 years. The Photo-Cat process is peroxide & ozone free, does not require wipers, eliminates secondary concerns, and has a service interval in excess of 18,000 hours.
